### FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

**FEBRUARY 4, 2021**

Today, February 4, 2021, President Joseph R. Biden Jr. granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Washington triggering the release of Federal funds to help communities recover from Wildfires and Straight-line Winds that occurred September 1-19, 2020.
